The scholarships financially assist nurses working to gain knowledge by attending educational/training forums such as conferences, workshops and short courses with nursing specific sessions that are recognised by the Continuous Professional Development Programmes of the Haemato-Oncology Colleges or Societies.

Shaun Rosen Nurses' Education and Training Scholarship:
The maximum amount available per application is \$4000.

Sylvia Hartog Nursing Scholarship:
The maximum amount available per application is \$2500.
