

How to leave a gift in your Will

Leaving a gift in your Will is simpler than you might think.

Many people choose to provide for their loved ones first and then consider leaving a gift to a cause close to their heart - one that reflects their values and the impact they wish to make.

Any gift, of any size, makes a meaningful difference.



Three simple steps:

STEP ONE

Decide who to include.

Consider which family, friends and organisations you would like to recognise in your Will.

STEP TWO

Choose the type of gift.

You may wish to leave:

- **A residual gift** - the remainder of your estate after loved ones are provided for
- **A percentage gift** - for example, 1% (or more) of your estate
- **A specific gift** - a nominated sum of money or particular asset

STEP THREE

Formalise your wishes.

Speak with your solicitor or estate planning professional to have your Will written or updated.

Suggested wording for including a Gift to Arrow.

We recommend speaking with your solicitor or estate planning professional to ensure your Will reflects your wishes clearly and accurately.

The following wording may assist:

"I give to Arrow Bone Marrow Transplant Foundation (ABN 42 135 196 244) of Suite 148 / 20-40 Meagher Street, Chippendale NSW 2008:

(insert one of the following)

(A) _____ % of my estate (insert percentage); or

(B) all my share and interest in the property know as (insert full address of property); or

(C) the sum of \$_____ (insert amount); or

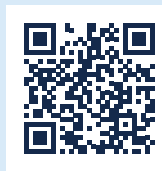
(D) the residue of my estate; and/or

(E) In the event that any of my nominated beneficiaries should predecease me then their bequest shall not fail but I give and bequeath the share of my deceased beneficiary to Arrow Bone Marrow Transplant Foundation to be used for its general purposes (or insert specific purpose), and I direct that the receipt of the Chief Executive Officer or other appropriate officer of the Arrow Bone Marrow Transplant Foundation shall be sufficient to discharge my Executor(s) who is not bound to see its application."

If you would prefer to leave your gift for a specific purpose - such as patient support, nurse education, or research - we would be pleased to provide tailored wording.
